## **NUSEED ACQUIRES PLANTTECH'S INVESTMENT IN CANOLA ALLIANCE**

PlantTech has decided to exit the Canola Alliance, the Australian canola breeding venture with the NSW Department of Primary Industries and Nufarm. To allow for a smooth transition Nufarm's seed division Nuseed will manage all future commercial transactions.

Nuseed is delighted to announce it has continued its expansion in canola breeding and marketing by acquiring PlantTech's investment in the Canola Alliance. The transaction will allow Nuseed to offer an increased canola range and to continue to work alongside the NSW Department of Primary Industries in one of Australia's leading canola breeding programmes.

PlantTech will continue to focus on its much larger seed interests in both field crops and pasture. This new direction will assist its customers by consolidating its range and focus into these two areas.

Under the arrangement, Nuseed will assume responsibility for commercialising the existing Canola Alliance product portfolio including the varieties Bravo TT, Rivette, Skipton and Warrior CL previously sold by PlantTech. Nuseed will simultaneously introduce a new mid-early TT canola variety "Tawriffic TT" into the market. It is expected that Tawriffic TT will replace Bravo TT in the future.
