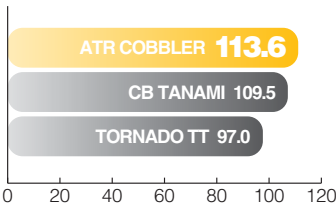

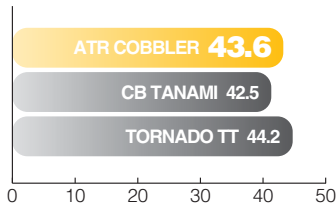

*NVT YIELD RESULTS (% SITE MEAN)



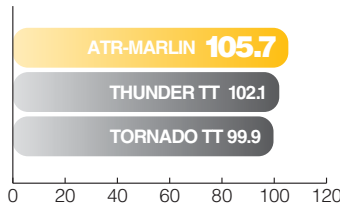

*NVT OIL RESULTS (% OIL)



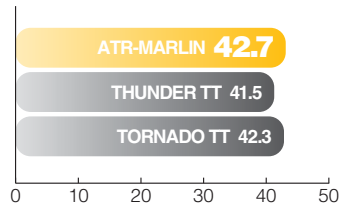

*NVT YIELD RESULTS (% SITE MEAN)



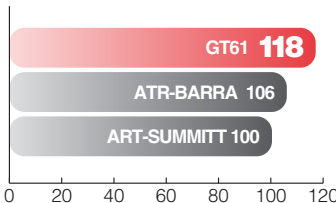

*NVT OIL RESULTS (% OIL)



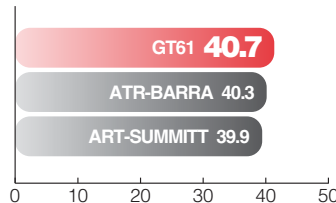
*Average across all 2007 NSW, VIC & SA NVT mid conventional canola yield trials (% oil) across 19 sites
