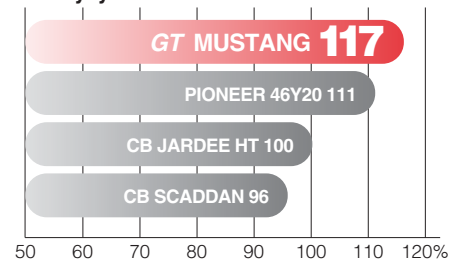

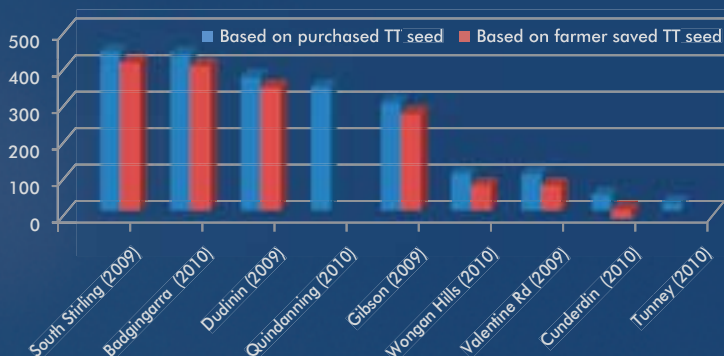

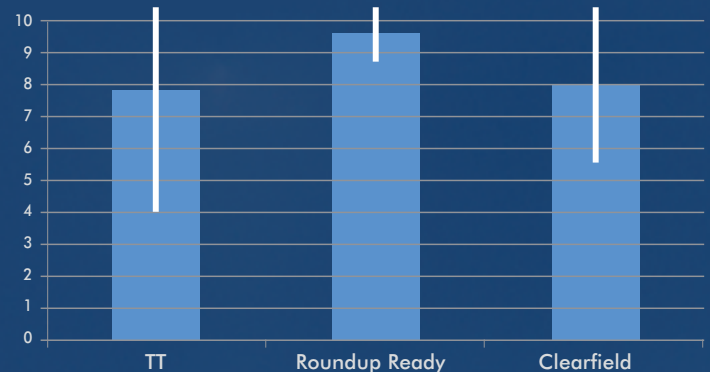

## Flexibility with new tank mix registrations
